

St Matthew's Displays

All displays in and around school should:

- Support learning and teaching.
- Enhance the school environment.
- Boards are neatly backed with a border around.
- All work should be double mounted, using a guillotine for any cutting needed.
- Colours for mounting to co-ordinate with backing paper and border.
- All work should be clearly labelled, showing the class and aim / purpose of work.
- If using the computer to do any labelling using Comic Sans, or other suitable font. (Think of the EAL Children).
- Have some handwritten labels, including staff and children's writing where appropriate.
- Be changed regularly.
- Show the children that you are proud of their work.
- Repaired / replaced once tatty.
- Working walls should be laminated whenever possible.
- All staples should be removed from boards each time.
- When using staples please put at a tilted angle as they are easier to remove.
