Have a peaceful half term and remember we are here if you need anything.

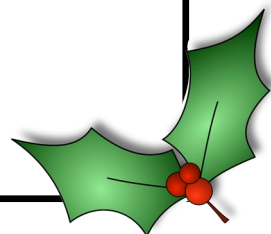


School starts back on, Tuesday 7th January 2025, at 8.45am.

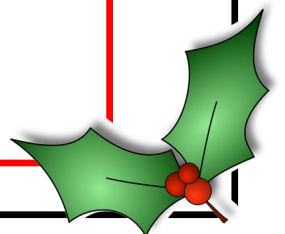

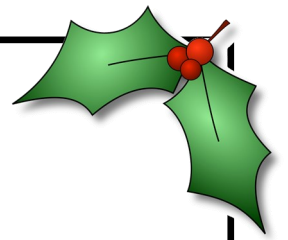


Reception's Nativity
